Activities

Included is a list of activities that will be happening at Camp Wehinahpay. Please review this with your scout and see what he ~~desires~~ to do at camp this summer. Select 4 merit badges to complete plus two alternates in case the first ones fill up. This is a great camp with many activities to stay busy. The week will be up before you know it and you will be on your way back home. Use your time wisely to get the most out of your summer camp.

Note the highlighted items in the activities. Some activities are high adventure and the scout must be 14 years or older. Other items that are highlighted require extra fees for the activity and requirements that must be accomplished before or after camp to complete the requirements for a merit badge.

New/First Year Scout Recommendations (TBD)

Scouts that are in their first year should sign up for the Pathfinders Program. The scout can earn the First Aid, Swimming and Nature merit badges, two of which are eagle required. In addition, basic scouting requirements covered in the scouting handbook for Scout to First Class.

There is also plenty of training and activities for leaders.

There is a required swim test for all aquatic activities including leaders if they participate.

Personal items to bring

Required Items

- Cot
- Sleeping Bag
- Flashlight or headlamp
- Canteen/Water Bottle
- Class A Uniform – Pants, Shirt, Neckerchief, Belt
- Class B Uniform – Troop T-shirt
- Clothing (socks, underwear, shorts, pants, shirts, sleeping clothes)
- Swimsuit
- Towel
- Jacket (temps vary from 40s at night to 80s during the day)
- Rain Gear
- Footwear tennis shoes, boots (appropriate footwear based on activities scout will be participating)
- Personal Hygiene (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo etc. (there are showers)
- Merit Badge Blue Cards filled out by scout and signed by the Scoutmaster/Assistant Scoutmaster

Optional Items

- Pillow
- Merit Badge Pamphlets
- Reading material
- Hanger (hang your uniform in your tent)
- Hiking Gear/Backpacking Gear (If you are doing high adventure think of the 10 items you should have)

Do Not Bring (these items may be brought for the ride but will remain in the vehicles after arrival)

- Electronic games
- iPod and MP3 players
- Cell phones
